Prepare a valuation for insurance and complete the S & K 2000, Inc. insurance proposal form.
Dispose of the items you don't want to ship.

Check with S & K 2000, Inc. about obtaining a tax refund on new purchases.
Ask for final accounts for gas, water and electricity.

Disconnect, clean and dry any electrical appliances that you wish to ship.
Disconnect lights for shipment and make wiring safe.
Dismantle furniture items as per the S & K 2000, Inc. schedule.
Arrange with neighbors to leave sufficient parking space for the removal vehicle. On moving
